






Equal Opportunities Workshop: Conflict Management: Constructively Dealing With Conflict











The ability to deal with conflict is a key factor for personal and professional success. In this workshop, participants will learn how to resolve conflicts effectively and confidently. They will be trained to distinguish between constructive and destructive conflicts and to facilitate communication to both prevent a disagreement from becoming a conflict and to de-escalate conflicts. Finally, the participants' ability to see the great potential in conflicts will be strengthened.
